Dear Sir/Madam,

As you may be aware, the Government e-Marketplace (GeM) has been established by the Government of India as the National Public Procurement Portal.

2. Besides Central Ministries and Departments, a large number of buyers from autonomous bodies and CPSEs under your Department may also be regularly procuring through GeM for fast, transparent and cost-effective procurement.

3. I would like to inform you that the Ministry of Finance has issued an OM No. F.6/14/2020-PPD dated 23.10.2020 making it mandatory to generate the GeM Availability Report and Past Transaction Summary (GeMAR&PTS) in all cases for creating bids outside GeM. All exemptions provided in the earlier OM have since been withdrawn and even in cases of urgency, the OM now mandates that the buyer has to upload the approval of associated finance in support of his claim for the urgent nature of procurement along with taking relevant screenshots. A copy of the said OM is enclosed for ready reference.

4. It is, therefore, requested that all Departments / CPSEs / other Buyer Organizations under your Ministry / Department may kindly be directed to act accordingly.

OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Subject: Relaxation on Global Tender Enquiry (GTE) under Rule 161(iv) of General Financial Rules (GFRs) 2017.

Attention is invited to this Department's OM of even no. Dated 15.05.2020 and 28.05.2020 regarding amendment in Rule 161(iv) of General Financial Rules(GFRs) 2017 stipulating that no Global Tender Enquiry (GTE) shall be invited for tenders upto Rs.200.00 crore or such limit as may be prescribed by this Department from time to time. It further stipulates that in exceptional cases, where the Ministry or the Department feels that there are special reasons for GTE, it may record its detailed justification and seek prior approval for relaxation to the above Rule from the competent authority i.e. Secretary (Coordination), Cabinet Secretariat.

2. In this regard, a doubt has arisen if the above instructions will also be applicable with respect to procurement of spares from Original Equipment Manufacturers (OEMs) or Original Equipment Suppliers (OES) or Original Part Manufactures (OPMs) on nomination basis, though there is no other source available and no competitive offers are invited.

3. In this regard, it is clarified that this office OM of even number dated 15.05.2020 will not be applicable on procurement of spares parts of the equipments/Plant & Machinery etc. on nomination basis from OEM/OES or OPM as no competitive tenders are invited in such cases.
